

Applications for 2023 Pennsylvania House Scholarship Available

BETHLEHEM - High school seniors interested in receiving financial assistance to help pay for college can now apply for the Pennsylvania House of Representatives' Scholarship.

Each year the program awards a four-year scholarship to two students preparing for post-secondary education. It is open to graduating high school seniors who are Pennsylvania residents with plans to attend a Pennsylvania college, university or career school as a full-time student.

To qualify, students must have attained a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average in high school. Other factors taken into consideration for the awards are a student's commitment to community, leadership qualities, extra-curricular activities and financial need.

The scholarship is privately funded by individual and corporate donors; no tax or other public funds are used. Scholarships are awarded through an independent panel of judges chosen by the foundation.

Warren County Shade Tree Commission Seeks Two Members


(BELVIDERE, NJ – January 20, 2023) – Do you love trees and want to help keep Warren County verdant? The Warren County Shade Tree Commission needs two new members to help regulate, plant and care for shade and ornamental trees and shrubbery in county parks, county road rights of way and other county-owned lands.

County Freeholders (now the Board of County Commissioners) established the Warren County Shade Tree Commission in 1982 and its volunteer members are tasked with ensuring the proper growth, care and protection of greenery on county-owned land and along 253 miles of county roadways.

The Shade Tree Commission meets nine times a year with other tasks taking place outside of meetings. Members receive training and attend the state Shade Tree Federation Convention annually to maintain education standards as required by the state.

Other Commission tasks have included running an Arbor Day essay and drawing contest at schools in Warren County, overseeing pruning of trees by utility companies, and developing a Community Forestry Management Plan for Warren County.
