It reads FLORY and was sand cast by his father Austin Flory while in the Navy at Pearl Harbor, just before the attack. He was on the USS Argonne, a repair ship that fired on enemy planes and aided in the recovery. It will be an honor to incorporate the plaque into the pavilion and pass down stories like this that we could never have imagined.
