No matter whether I come to do a breakdown call or annual tune-up or a whole system installation at your home, there is a warranty that comes with that. It is more about responsibility really, but it is there for your peace of mind and just in case you need it. Warranty problems always jump ahead of anything on the schedule when they arise because they are for people who already have relied on us to resolve a problem or make adjustments to their system.

A return visit can be necessary for more reasons than you can imagine and brand new parts that are defective or that have a very short life are only a few of those reasons. No matter what the reason is, the problem needs to be resolved, and it needs to be done right away. There are ways people try to save money on service and saving money is never a bad thing. Plenty of liability insurance in case of a disaster and a truck full of replacement parts as well as someone trained who will put them on 7 days a week. This is a candid explanation why some things cost more.

Choose your service company or person wisely because they are not all alike nobody likes to pay for something twice. But it happens far too often when someone doesn't take responsibility for their work or can't respond because they are at their real job.

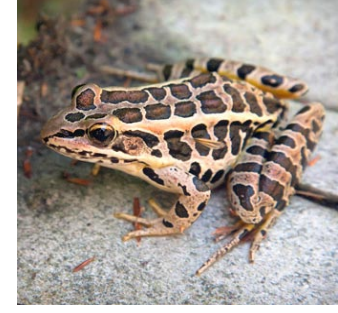
River Road Closure to Protect Breeding Amphibians

BUSHKILL, PA: Motorists can expect River Road within Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area to be closed on several evenings over the next few weeks to protect breeding amphibians. The trigger for the road closures will be forecasts calling for evening rain with mild temperatures—usually in the 50's. Since the amphibians are active principally at night and have completed their treks by dawn, the road will be closed at approximately 4:00 p.m. and will remain closed until approximately 6:30 a.m.

Each year the National Park Service take steps to protect migrating amphibians by closing River Road in Middle Smithfield Township between park headquarters and Hialeah Picnic Area on several mild, rainy nights from March to mid-April. This closure allows vulnerable amphibians to crawl or hop from distances of a few hundred feet to sometimes more than a quarter mile, to moist breeding pools without the risk of being crushed by vehicle tires.
