### FREE AMATEUR RADIO LICENSE CLASSES

Amateur Radio (ham radio) is a popular hobby and service that brings people, electronics and communication together. People use ham radio to talk across town, around the world, or even into space, all without the Internet, land-line phones or cell phones. It's fun, social, educational, and can be a lifeline during times of need. The Delaware-Lehigh Amateur Radio Club offers free classes to prepare interested persons for the short entry-level FCC Amateur Radio license test and the start of enjoyment in amateur radio communications.

Here's a chance for you to learn about amateur radio for emergency communication, in public service events, radio contests, or casual conversations with other "hams" potentially anywhere in the world. You'll learn how radios and antennas work, how to set up and operate a station at home, in your ve-


