Rt. 611 Update

UPPER MT. BETHEL - 611 UPDATE Thank you Rep Tarah Probst for taking the lead w/PennDOT & thank you PennDOT for being GREAT with communication!!!

NPS PERMIT PROCESS? As Per PennDOT, next week NPS should have the rest of what is needed to finish the emergency permit process. They have been collaborating on this since mid-February. At that time, it was anticipated to take 4-6 weeks.

EVERYONE'S GOAL? Get the scaling done ASAP, so they can POSSIBLY open one lane.

HOW LONG WILL ONE OR BOTH LANES BE CLOSED? - Mid October the soonest- Once emergency permits are approved, 30 days to mobilized. 6 months to remove the hazards (trees, rock etc), pin the mesh or other stabilization.

DRJTBC / TOLLS? Unfortunately, it appears there is some regulation that prohibits any pay back on the tolls. Officials looked to see if a few of the ground zero towns, that need to now pay two I-80 Water Gap Bridge Tolls, could get reimbursed. Reminder – Tolls collected pay for ALL the Delaware Rive Joint Toll Bridge crossings. They do NOT go towards PA or NJ roadways.
