Northampton County 2023 Envirothon Results, Bangor 1st Place

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY - The Northampton County Conservation District (NCCD) held its 27th annual Envirothon competition at Louise Moore Park in Bethlehem and Lower Nazareth Townships today, April 20, 2023. The Envirothon is an environmental competition for students in grades 9 through 12.

This year, seven schools competed with twelve teams from Bangor Area High School, Freedom High School, Nazareth Area High School, Northampton Area High School, Pen Argyl Area High School, Saucon Valley High School, and Moravian Academy.

A team consists of five students and an advisor. Students were tested in five areas: Wildlife, Forestry, Soils and Land Use, Aquatic Ecology, and a current environmental issue. This year's topic was Adapting to a Changing
