



Rep. Wild Introduces the Child Care for Working Families Act

BETHLEHEM - This week, I introduced the Child Care for Working Families Act to ensure child care is affordable and accessible to all families who need it. We're experiencing a child care crisis here in Pennsylvania: 38,000 children waitlisted, 1,600 classrooms closed, and 100s of positions unfilled.

Over 1,500 children in the Lehigh Valley are on a waitlist for child care. Tackling the child care crisis is a huge need for working families – and that's why I'm very proud to have introduced the Child Care for Working Families Act.

Before I came to Congress, I was a working mom, meaning that the struggle of finding child care is familiar to me. I once had to bring my very active toddler son to court with me due to short staffing at his child care center. For all the moms, dads, parents, kids, families out there, it's time to pass this bill to open more care providers, lower parents' costs, and ensure every family can access high-quality care.
