When the Lonergans learned Jason would be receiving the Employee of the Month award, they invited Mission staff for doughnuts and coffee to celebrate Jason and the Allentown Rescue Mission.

They hired the Clean Team Workforce based on referrals from other businesses in the area and couldn't be happier with the service. In the future, Jason longs to be independent and maintain a stable life. "I want to be successful and live right, nothing extravagant."
