“Road Trip” Being Presented by “The New Approach”

Once again it's that time of year when “The New Approach” vocal performance group, now in their 39th year, will hold their annual show to raise money for the Dale & Francis Hughes Cancer Center. The 39th annual show will send ALL monies received to the treatment center run by Pocono Medical Center. Last year the group donated \$9300 to the cancer center and hope to give more because this facility is doing such a great job for the patients and families dealing with cancer.

This year's show is called “Road Trip” and true to it's name, the upbeat contemporary music and dance takes you on a journey from New York to Los Angeles. Headed by director, Mrs. Jean Pinto, and assistant director, Mr. Terry Toth, the 100 minute show lets the audience experience everything from Broadway, to Country Western, to Motown, to Rock -n-Roll. The group has a live pit band and 70 cast members ranging in age from 3 years old up to 60 years old.

The New Approach has had a long history when dealing with cancer. What started out as a neighborhood fundraiser for a friend stricken with cancer, grew into a Slatebelt must see show. The group's mission is not just one of vocal and dance performance, but a far greater goal of fighting to rid the disease from existence. Everyone in the group has had a close connection with the disease, either personally, or with a family member, or a friend. The disease is not selective about who it chooses. The director's own daughter, Kathi, was taken at a young age with the disease after having directed this group for three decades. The crowd gets to see the unique show creation and the full forced delivery of professional music but they also get to meet inspiring folks that want to continue this fight against cancer.

The show is being held at the air conditioned Bangor Middle School on Friday, August 7th at 7:30PM, Saturday, August 8th at 7:30PM and Sunday, August 9th at 2PM. The show is appropriate for all ages! Tickets can be purchased at the door the days of the performance, or you can get them prior to the show at Horn's Outdoor Center in Mt. Bethel or at St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Plainfield Township.

Come out this weekend and see the show and help support this worthy cause that will benefit many families dealing with cancer.
