Rep. Wild Delivers \$1 Million Investment in Northampton County Gracedale Nursing Home

This week, I was proud to announce that \$1 million in Community Project Funding has come home to Gracedale Nursing Home, right here in Northampton County! Gracedale is the largest long-term care facility under one roof in Pennsylvania and also provides members of our community with short-term rehabilitation, Alzheimer care, and respite care.

These funds will be used to fix and improve elevators, smoke detectors, and refrigerators. Additionally, funds will be used to install a Therapeutic Garden, which will feature elements specifically designed to aid residents with dementia. I am glad to have secured this funding to help improve the lives of Gracedale patients and their families, and I'm thankful to Northampton County Executive Lamont McClure for his partnership in this effort – and I will continue working to bring federal dollars home to our community.

Rep. Wild Announces \$2.2 Billion in Infrastructure Funding for Pennsylvania

This week, I was thrilled to announce that Pennsylvania will receive over \$2.2 billion to improve our roads and bridges and build up our electric vehicle infrastructure! These funds from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, which I was proud to help pass into law, will both strengthen the Greater Lehigh Valley's economy AND improve the health and safety of our community.

Over the next five years, our commonwealth is expected to receive over \$13.2 billion to fund improvements to the 3,353 bridges and over 7,540 miles of highway in Pennsylvania currently in need of repair.
