Lehigh Valley - The Greater Valley YMCA Community Gala, presented by Lehigh Valley Health Network, was held on Saturday, at the Centennial Catering & Conference Center in Center Valley, PA. The Gala featured Keynote Speaker Larry Holmes, as well as celebration of several community leaders through the 2023 Y Champion Awards presentation.

At the Gala, Holmes shared his experiences as a youth growing up in the Lehigh Valley and visiting the Y frequently. The gala fundraiser also feature dinner, additional award presentations, a Phillipsburg High School quarter, DJ Don from Rockin' Ramaley, as well as live and online silent auctions. The evening also provided updates on the Y's nonprofit, charitable mission programming, as essential dollars are raised for programs like the Y's Financial Assistance, Allentown Warming Station, and free youth and family meals programs, among others. The online silent auction, which runs from November 1-11, features items from local businesses, craft artisans, jewelry and more.

During the evening, the Greater Valley YMCA Easton/Phillipsburg Branch will celebrated 125 years of serving the community since its founding on November 7, 1898.

Also at the Gala, the Greater Valley YMCA acknowledged community leaders' contributions to the YMCA's mission throughout 2023.
