Slate Belt Heritage Center & Museum Will Hold Their Monthly Historic Presentation

BANGOR - The Slate Belt Heritage Center & Museum will hold their monthly historic presentation on Sunday, March 8th at 2:00PM. The Center is located at 30 North 1st Street, Bangor. The public is invited to this free program.

Guest speaker will be Tim Betz who is Curator of Exhibitions at the Northampton County Historical and Genealogical Society in Easton, PA. His book, Making History: Makerspaces for Museums and Historic Sites, explores how learning and teaching historic trades and crafts is an important way to learn about the past for museum goers, museum professionals, and scholars.

He teaches art history at Kutztown University of Pennsylvania and is completing his PhD in history at Lehigh University, where he focuses on the role of collections and material culture in the shaping of the Spanish Empire.

The Untold American Revolution in Northampton County. This talk explores what the lived experience of the American Revolution was like for people who lived it in Northampton County. Moving beyond famous figures and battlefield stories, this talk reveals how ordinary people in Northampton County experienced war, uncertainty, and dramatic social change. Drawing on local records, objects, and firsthand accounts, it offers a vivid, human look at how the Revolution unfolded close to home.
