## Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program

The Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program has opened for older Pennsylvanians and individuals with disabilities. Applications for 2025 Property Tax/Rent Rebates are due by June 30, 2026.

Anyone 65 and older, widows and widowers 50 and older, and people with disabilities 18 and older who have a household income of less than \$48,110 are eligible to apply, which marks an increase of more than \$1,500 from last year's income level. Please note that half of Social Security income is excluded. The maximum standard rebate has also been increased and is reflected below:

INCOME	MAXIMUM REBATE
\$0-\$8,550	\$1000
\$8,551-\$16,040	\$770
\$16,041-\$19,240	\$460
\$19,241-\$48,110	\$380

Applicants are encouraged to apply online for the fastest review process. Online applications are available at [https://my-path.pa.gov/\\_/](https://my-path.pa.gov/_/). Paper applications that can be mailed are available by clicking here.

## Tax Season is Here – Make Sure to Take Advantage of Tax Relief

Tax season is here, and I want to take a moment to remind eligible Pennsylvanians and their families to take advantage of these opportunities to maximize your refund.

**Working Pennsylvanians Tax Credit**

New this year is the Working Pennsylvanians Tax Credit, which can put up to \$805 back in your pocket. Modelled after the federal Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), the new state-level credit equals 10 percent of the federal credit. Anyone who qualifies for the federal EITC will automatically receive both credits.

The new tax credit is expected to deliver \$193 million in total relief to 940,000 Pennsylvanians! Use this calculator to see if you qualify and estimate your credit.

In addition, the Child and Dependent Care Enhancement Tax Credit can help ease the cost of childcare for eligible Pennsylvania families. Recently, Pennsylvania tripled the amount of the credit, which now matches the eligibility requirements and the amount of the federal tax credit.

More than 200,000 families statewide are now eligible for the credit, thanks to the expansion, which can range between \$600 and \$2,100, depending on income level and number of dependents.

REMINDER: Pennsylvanians who received Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits in 2025 will receive a 1099-G form, which reports taxable UC income and is required to file federal and state tax returns. Forms are now available in claimants' online UC dashboards, and paper copies are being mailed and will arrive over the coming weeks. ### LOWERING COSTS FOR FAMILIES

Working Pennsylvanians Tax Credit



NEW

- Equals 10% of the Federal Earned Income Tax Credit (up to \$800).
- Expected to benefit nearly 1 million Pennsylvanians.
- If you qualify for the federal EITC, you will automatically receive **both** credits.

Child & Dependent Care Enhancement Tax Credit

- Helps ease childcare or dependent care costs for working families.
- Equals 100% of the federal Child Care Tax Credit (up to \$2,100).
- Claim it when filing your Pennsylvania Personal Income Tax Return.
