Key dates and process improvements include:

Required Pre-Application (due April 1, 2026): Applicants must first submit a pre-application, allowing PHMC staff to provide early guidance on historical significance, documentation, and eligibility before a full nomination is prepared.

Final Application Deadline (June 1, 2026): Applicants invited to proceed after pre-application review must submit final materials by this date.

Nominations may be submitted by individuals, historical societies, local governments, nonprofit organizations, and community groups. All proposals are evaluated by a panel of independent historians and scholars from across Pennsylvania and approved by the agency’s commissioners.
