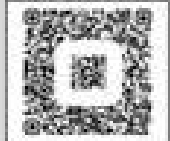

As we prepare to celebrate our nation's 250th anniversary, I am pleased to offer a unique opportunity for a high school student in the 40th Senatorial District to take part in a special Pennsylvania Senate Ceremonial Meeting in partnership with America250PA. One student will be selected through an essay competition to join me in Philadelphia for this historic event.

This is an exciting opportunity for a local student to experience a ceremonial Senate meeting first-hand and engage directly in the civic process. As we approach this important milestone in our nation's history, it is critical that we invest in the next generation and encourage meaningful civic engagement.

This event continues a long-standing tradition of holding Senate meetings in Philadelphia to mark major anniversaries of our nation's founding, including past gatherings in 1926 and 1976. This year's event will take place on Tuesday, May 5, at the National Constitution Center. I will have the opportunity to invite one student from our district, along with a parent or guardian, to attend and represent our community. A travel stipend will be provided to help offset associated costs.

I encourage interested students in grades 9 through 12 to apply. This is a meaningful way to learn, engage, and be part of a historic moment for both our Commonwealth and our country.

To be considered, students must submit a 250–500-word essay responding to the prompt: "What the Declaration of Independence means to me." Essays are due by March 30 at 12:00 p.m., and the selected student will be notified on April 3.
