HARRISBURG - Cal is a junior in the Class of 2027 and has already distinguished himself as a leader, scholar, performer, and dedicated member of his community.

He is a three-year varsity letter winner in Bangor Cheer and currently serves as captain of the varsity squad. His team accomplishments include membership on the Colonial League and District 11 Runner-Up cheer squads, and his individual achievements are equally impressive.

Cal was selected to represent Pennsylvania on the Big 33 PSFCA Pennsylvania squad and is a three-time Universal Cheerleaders Association All-American.



Virginia Kraus

Saucon Valley's Virginia Kraus makes PIAA history with fourth win. In the 86-year history of PIAA cross country, only nine runners have captured three state championships.

Only two had the chance to make it a perfect four-for-four but neither succeeded.

Virginia Kraus set out this past fall 2025 PIAA Cross Country Championships at the in Hershey, Pa. as the third with that remarkable opportunity, looking to create her own exclusive group in PIAA history.

With a personal best time of 17:48 on the course – by an absurd 30 seconds – the Saucon Valley senior did exactly that, becoming the first four-time state champion in the history of PIAA cross country, beating out Gwynedd Mercy's Reese Miller by 31 seconds for a fourth consecutive gold medal.

For Kraus, it was all about settling the nerves and trusting the process that got her to an unprecedented stage.



Boscola Announces \$80,000 in Funding to Lafayette College and Moravian University to Combat Sexual Assault

Bethlehem, PA – March 17, 2026 – State Senator Lisa M. Boscola announced today that Lafayette College and Moravian University have been awarded grants by the Pennsylvania Department of Education through the "It's On Us PA" initiative, whose goal is to raise awareness of and combat sexual assault on college campuses.

"I'm pleased to announce state funds will be used by Lafayette College and Moravian University to further their own "It's On Us PA" program goals, which focus on the prevention of sexual violence on college campuses," Boscola said. "Pennsylvania continues to be a leader in partnering with our institutions of higher education to implement strategies to prevent sexual violence and improve campus safety."

Lafayette College and Moravian University were awarded \$40,000 for their respective "It's On Us PA" initiatives. Moravian University will use the state grant to educate students about consent and boost campus awareness of reporting options and resources. Moravian will also partner with student organizations to ensure information, particularly awareness of affirmative consent, reaches high-risk groups.

The It's On Us campaign is a national initiative initially championed by President Barack Obama in 2014. In 2016, Pennsylvania was the first state in the nation to launch a statewide campaign to combat sexual assault and violence. It's On Us PA is a statewide campaign that invites everyone to play a role in ending sexual assault. It's On Us PA brings together college and university presidents, superintendents, administrators, teachers, students, families, and community members to reframe the conversation around sexual violence and pledge to be part of the solution.
