Deadline Extended for Home Heating Assistance Program in Pa. 2025-26 LIHEAP Application Deadline Extended to May 8

Pennsylvania residents now have additional time to apply for help with home heating costs, as the deadline for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) has been extended to May 8.

The LIHEAP program provides financial assistance to eligible households to help cover heating bills, along with crisis grants for emergencies such as fuel shortages or broken heating equipment. Eligibility is based on household income and size. For example, the maximum annual income is \$23,940 for an individual and \$49,500 for a family of four, with an additional \$8,520 allowed for each extra household member. Residents can apply online through the state's COMPASS system, by calling 1-866-857-7095, or by contacting their local County Assistance Office (Northampton County Assistance Office 610.829.4800 | Lehigh County Assistance Office 610.821.6509).



There are two ways to apply for LIHEAP:

Online: Apply for benefits online using? COMPASS, the online tool for Pennsylvanians to apply for and manage health and human service programs.

On paper: You can download a paper application, print it, fill it out, and return it to your?local county assistance office.
