## Bear Safety Tips from BearWise

Summer camping season is here, so everyone must be BearWise this summer. Here are some tips to help deter from bear encounters while camping:

Keep a clean camp.  
Don't burn food scraps or trash in your fire ring or grill.  
Clean and store your BBQ grill when not in use.  
Secure your food and trash and Do NOT store them in your tent.  
Cook downwind and as far away from your tent (or shelter) as possible.  
Set up backcountry camps away from dense cover and natural food sources.  
Always enjoy bears from a distance. Never approach them!
