Boscola Bill Strengthening Penalties for Criminals Skimming SNAP Benefits Advances Through Committee

My legislation to strengthen Pennsylvania's response to SNAP and EBT skimming crimes took an important step forward this week, receiving unanimous approval as amended from the Senate Health & Human Services Committee.

Senate Bill 362 would modernize Pennsylvania law to better address the growing threat of criminals stealing Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) information through skimming devices, scanners, reencoders, and other technologies used to capture and misuse recipients' access device information.

The legislation was amended in committee with input from the Office of the State Inspector General and The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services to ensure the bill reflects current methods used by criminals and strengthens prosecutors' ability to hold offenders accountable.

The bill now advances for further consideration in the legislative process.
