Get ready for three days of hands-on learning, discovery, and fun at the upcoming "Grass, Goats and Uninvited Guests" 4-H Camp! This exciting educational camp will give youth the opportunity to learn about goat health while participating in engaging activities designed to make animal science come alive.

Throughout the camp, participants will explore the fascinating world of small ruminants, learning how parasites affect goats and how farmers and veterinarians work to keep animals healthy. Campers will become animal health detectives as they investigate signs of illness, examine simulated blood samples, conduct fecal egg counts, learn about body condition scoring, and discover how parasites impact livestock production. Not only will we practice on plush animals, but we will also have visits from real goats, rabbits, and other animals!

Using interactive models, youth will build critical thinking skills and problem-solving skills while gaining a deeper understanding of animal agriculture. This camp is designed to be educational and engaging for all participants.

Whether participants are experienced livestock exhibitors or simply curious about animals and science, the "Grass, Goats and Uninvited Guests" Camp offers something for everyone. Nazareth To Celebrate America's 250th Birthday With A Free Festival For The Community.

Nazareth, PA—To mark the 250th anniversary of our nation's founding, the Moravian Historical Society, the Nazareth Economic Development Commission, and the County of Northampton Department of Community and Economic Development are hosting a free community festival on Saturday, July 4, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. This community celebration will feature a patriotic program, living history demonstrations, the Nazareth Farmers Market, and live music on the 3-acre historic site where Nazareth started in 1740.

The day kicks off with Nazareth's Annual Kazoo Parade, a beloved tradition where everyone is invited to join in the fun. Parade participants gather at the Nazareth Area High School on Center Street at 8:00 a.m. for some live music. The parade steps off at 9:00 a.m. and marchers will play patriotic songs as they make their way to the Whitefield House. This year, in honor of America's 250th birthday, the Brandywine Colonials Fife and Drum Corps will lead the parade. The Brandywine Colonials are dedicated to preserving America's patriotic musical heritage through educational programs and performances.

Visitors can take a tethered hot-air balloon ride (weather permitting) thanks to Unity Bank.

We are thrilled to have two of the Lehigh Valley's favorite bands performing: TimeWhys and the Craig Thatcher Quartet featuring Billy Wear, Chico Huff, and Cliff Starkey.

There will be lots of free patriotic activities for the kids, including Colonial games, crafts, and presentations of Nazareth Area School District's Fifth Grade Colonial Days Projects.

Free parking is available at the Nazareth Area High School where a shuttle bus will take you to the Moravian Historical Society.

The Nazareth Farmers Market will relocate for the day to the Moravian Historical Society, where additional vendors will be set up.
